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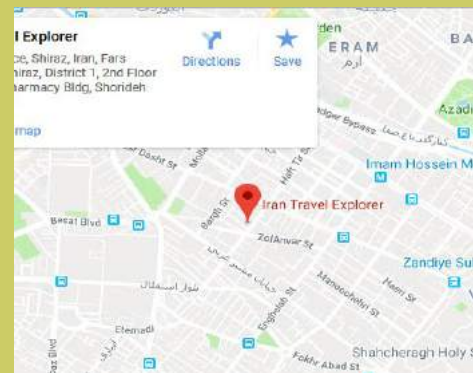

Day 1: Arriving in Tehran & start the tour

[Tehran](#) is a modern metropolis town, heritages awesome palace from Pahlavi and Qajar dynasty. In the morning tour is began by visiting [Golestan Palace](#) and [Tehran grand Bazaar](#). Golestan Literally means rose land palace. This is marvellous inheritance from Qajar. The significant attribute of this palace is Marble Throne. You will also visit [National Museum of Iran](#) and [Jewellery Museum](#). Here is the most dazzling collection of gemstones and jewellery known in the world. At last you will visit [Milad Tower](#) also known Tehran Tower, which is a multi-purposed and sixth-tallest tower in the world. You will also enjoy of a traditional dinner at Milad's tower restaurant. Overnight Tehran.

Day 2: Fly to Shiraz, the city of gardens

After breakfast and check out hotel you will transfer to Mehrabad airport to fly to [Shiraz](#). Today you will visit mixture of Iran symbols in different highlights. Bazaar, mosque, traditional house and garden can be visited through your journey in Shiraz. In the morning, [Pink mosque \(Nasir al Molk\)](#) is really worthy to visit. Sun lights display pink lights through this five concave mosque and represent eye catching perspective. Next, visit Zandieh complex which includes [Bath](#), [mosques](#), [bazaar](#) and [citadel](#). Royal district constructions which are built during Karim Khan Zand's Monarchy. Overnight Shiraz.



GOLESTAN PALACE

Golestan Palace Compound is the best example of Qajar era's art and architecture. It is located in Tehran city center and showcases the most outstanding royal buildings used by Qajar and Pahlavi kings for residence, festivity, administration.

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF IRAN

National Museum of Iran, located in Tehran, aging more than 70 years, and containing 300,000 museum objects. It is not only the largest museum of History and Archaeology of the country, but ranks as one of the few most prestigious museums of the world in regard to grand volume, diversity and quality of its huge monuments.

PINK MOSQUE (NASIR ALMOLK)

The Nasir al-Mulk Mosque also known as the *Pink Mosque* is a traditional mosque in Shiraz, Iran. It was built under the Qajar Persia. The mosque includes extensive colored glass in its facade, and displays other traditional elements.

ZANDIYE COMPLEX

Zandiyeh Complex One of the most elegant architectural of Zand dynasty is *Zandiyeh Complex* located in Shiraz, as the capital of this dynasty. It contains Arg-Karim Khan, Vakil Bath, Vakil Mosque, Vakil Bazaar. They were named after Karim Khan, the founder of Zand dynasty.

PERSEPOLIS PALACE

Persepolis was the capital of the Achaemenid Empire. It was built on an immense half-artificial, half-natural terrace, where the king of kings created an impressive palace complex inspired by Mesopotamian models.

NECROPOLIS (NAGHSHE ROSTAM)

Naqš-e *Rustam*, probably the ancient Nupistaš, is situated about five kilometers northwest of Persepolis, the capital of the ancient Achaemenid empire. As is shown by a pre-Achaemenid relief and several old graves.

ARDESHIR PALACE

This *palace* is about 2-3 hrs south of Shiraz just north of the small town. It lacks the 'wow factor' but is worth visiting if interested in ancient history as it is the *palace* of the founder of the Sassanian dynasty and the region has connections to Alexander the Great and the Achaemenids.

DOKHTAR CASTEL

Name *Dokhtar Castle* (The Maiden Castle) is because of its attribution to Venus (the goddess of blessing and beauty) that was worshiped and respected.

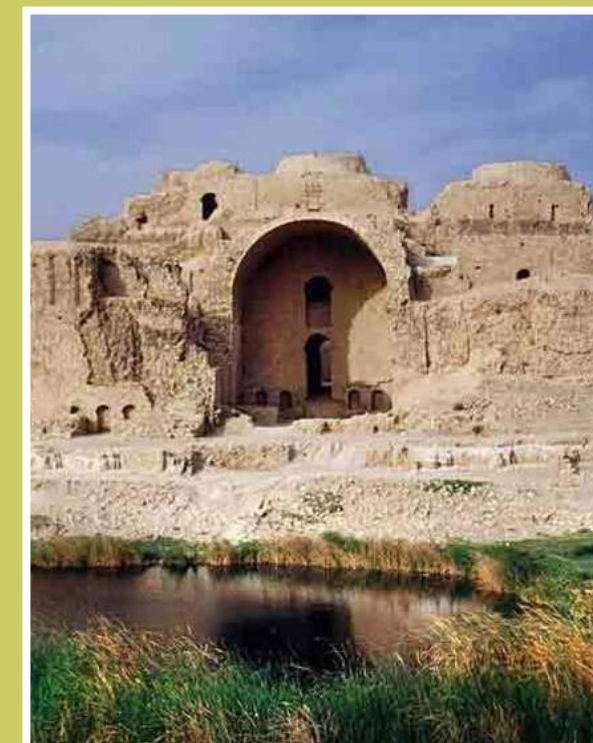


Day 3: Visiting the great Persepolis

Day 4: Road trip to Firoz Abad

After breakfast and check out hotel you will drive toward [Firuzabad](#) to start Nomadic Tribes in Iran. Excursion to Firuzabad to visit [Ardashir Palace](#), [Dokhtar Castle](#), Qashqai Carpet Weaving.





Day 5: Nature adventure

Visiting [Haygher Canyon](#) which is located at Firuzabad South West (35 KM), and living with the tribe.

Day 6: Road trip to Kazerun

After breakfast you will drive toward [Kazerun](#). You will visit [Anahita Temple](#), Bishapur Museum, Tang Chogan Relives and [Bishapur Cave](#).



HAYGHER CANYON

Hayghar *Canyon*, known as the Grand *Canyon* of Iran. Little known to locals and tourists, this *canyon* gives some of the most amazing views of all Iran.

Anahita temple is one of the famous buildings of the ancient city of Bishapur in Kazeroun town which is related to Anahita, the goddess of water. Next to Shapur castle in the ancient valley of Bishapour, there is a large square room known as Anahita temple of Bishapur.

Bishapur is between Shiraz and Kazeroon City. there is on of biggest statue of King Shapour at entrance of Shapour *Cave*. and very beautiful inscription on the mountains wall.

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DASHT-E ARZHAN

Eslamabad is a village in *Dasht-e Arzhan* Rural District, *Arzhan* District, Shiraz County, Fars Province, Iran. The wetland of *Dasht-e-Arzhan* is an outstanding example of a freshwater wetland, characteristic of the highlands of western Iran.

YASUJ

The city of *Yasuj* in southwestern Iran is the capital of Kohgiluyeh and Boyer-Ahmad Province and home to various nomadic tribes. Bashar River flows through the city which is situated at the foot of the Zagros Mountain range and 20-kilometers from the snow-capped Mount Dena.

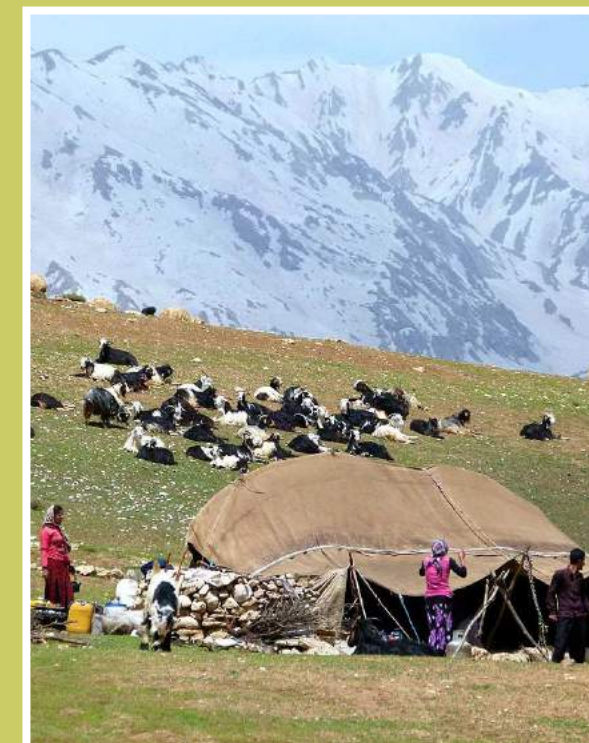
Day 7: Nomad tribes

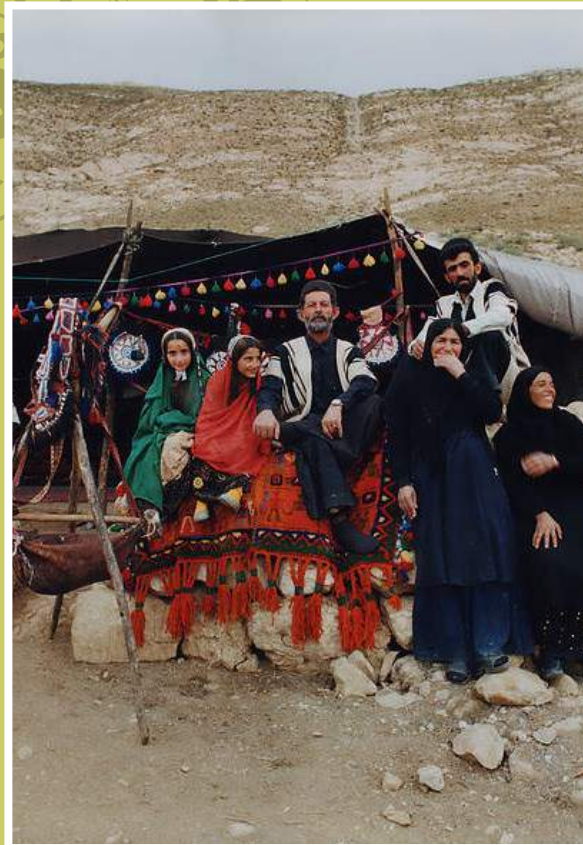
After breakfast you will drive toward [Dasht-e Arzhan](#). Visiting Dasht Arjan nomad tribes.

You are going to start a journey to [Shahr-e Kord](#) and visiting Shahr-e Kord “[Bakhtiari](#)” nomad tribes.

Day 10: Road trip to Isfahan

After breakfast drive toward Isfahan. Start visiting [Chehelsotun Palace](#), [Naghsh-e Jahan Square](#) and [Sheikh Lotfollah Mosque](#), [Emam Mosque \(Shah mosque\)](#) and [Ali Qapu Building](#) and the handicraft workshops around the Naghsh-e Jahan Square. At the end you are going to visit old bridges ([Khajoo](#) & [Si-o-se pol](#)).



BAKHTIARI NOMAD

The *Bakhtiari* are the largest *tribe* in Iran and with an history of about eight thousand years.

NAGHSHE JAHAN SQ.

Naghsh-e Jahan Square (Design of the world) officially known as Imam Square, situated at the center of Isfahan city, Iran. It is an important historical site and one of UNESCO's World Heritage Sites. The square is surrounded by buildings from the Safavid era.

SHEIKH LOTFOLLAH MOSQUE

Sheikh Lotfollah Mosque is one of the architectural masterpieces of Safavid Iranian architecture, standing on the eastern side of Naqsh-e Jahan Square, Isfahan.

ALI QAPU PALACE

The Ali Qapu is a Safavid palace in Isfahan, Iran which was originally designed as a vast portal in the early 17th century and then it turned to a six-story palace with a series of additional architectural elements over a sixty year period to accommodate court functions.

HASHT BEHESHT GARDEN

The **Hasht Behesht** (literally translated Eight Heavens) is a historic mansion and one of the last residences of the Safavid Kings'. The Mansion was one of the most significant building in the world.

JAMEH MOSQUE OF ISFAHAN

Located in the historic centre of *Isfahan*, the Masjed-e Jāmé ('Friday *mosque*') can be seen as a stunning illustration of the evolution of *mosque* architecture.
